**Town of Ballston Comprehensive Plan Update – Mobile Visioning Workshops**

**Ballston Spa, N.Y.** – The Town of Ballston invites community members to participate in a pair of Mobile Visioning Workshops as part of the Comprehensive Plan Update public engagement process. The mobile workshops are scheduled for Thursday, October 1, 2020 from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Living Hope Christian Church at 978 Saratoga Road (NYS Route 50), Ballston Lake, NY and Saturday, October 3, 2020 from 9:00 am –to 11:00 am at the Anchor Diamond Park at 1-17 Middleline Road, Ballston Lake, NY. The Mobile Visioning Workshops will be hosted in the parking lots at each location offering an opportunity for socially-distanced, in-person public engagement. The mobile workshops will provide an overview of the Comprehensive Plan Update process and gather input from the community about their vision for the Town of Ballston. Masks are required and social distancing protocols will be in place.

“Identifying a vision for the future of our Town is important. We need to hear feedback from all community members and since a more traditional public workshop is not possible at this time, these mobile workshops create a unique opportunity to have some level of in-person engagement in a safe way. We hope the public participates,” stated Eric Connolly, Town Supervisor.

The Town of Ballston has initiated an update to its 2006 Comprehensive Plan to reflect the needs of today and identify a vision for the future. The Comprehensive Plan Update will create a framework for the future of the Town for a range of topic areas, including but not limited to land use, economic development, infrastructure, transportation, neighborhoods, agriculture, the environment, and housing.

The project is being led by the Town Board and facilitated by M.J. Engineering and Land Surveying, P.C. of Clifton Park.
